IMPORTANT - BRUCELLOSIS SCHEMES

Cows or heifers calving at the show before the time of judging **WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO COMPETE**. Cows or heifers which appear about to calve will be placed in isolation and after calving return home as soon as practicable. Cows or heifers showing any abnormal discharge or which appear to be about to abort or which do abort **WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO COMPETE** and will be placed in isolation at once. As soon as samples have been taken the animals together with all other show animals from the same registered premises **MUST** be returned home and will not be allowed to compete.

"THE C. H. MORRIS" PERPETUAL CHALLENGE CUP

Will be awarded to the Herdsman of the SUPREME CHAMPION. All entries will be bona-fide property of the Exhibitor three months prior to the Show, and no animal to take a prize unless it is registered in the Hereford Herd Book or eligible for registration.

The Savills Silver Salver will be awarded to the Champion Poll Hereford and an identical Silver Salver for the Champion Horned Hereford.

To be halter led and handler will be asked rudimentary questions on their animal. Rosettes will be awarded and prize cards. There is NO entry fee.
