# **PRESERVES AND PRODUCE**

## **General Guidelines**

Jars should be made of clear glass and free from all commercial/trade marks, whether on the lid or base. If no seal of preservation is present, the item is not acceptable.

The containers should be clean, unblemished and filled to the rim.

Labels should be plain, neat and straight and of suitable size for the container.

Place label between the seams of the jar.

The label should state the contents and day, month and year of making.
