SHEEP AND GOAT HEALTH SCHEME

MAEDI VISNA ACCREDITED FLOCK SCHEME

Exhibitors of sheep must either be Fully Accredited Members of the Maedi Visna Flock Scheme, or Non Members of the Scheme. Accommodation identified by a prominent notice will be provided for Maedi Visna Accredited Sheep.

1. Separate transport to and from the Show will be required for Accredited sheep.
2. The separate unloading point at the Show must be used.
3. Accredited sheep to be penned in the separate penning which are separated by 2 metres from non designated sheep.
4. In order to gain admission to the designated approved section of the Show all scheme sheep must be accompanied by proof of status - Accredited sheep must have a SH20 Certificate.
5. All Classes, Accredited and Non Designate, may be shown in the same ring, 2 metres separation shall be kept between sheep of the two categories.
6. Entry forms must state that the flock is Maedi Visna Accredited.
7. The Society is Licenced to conduct a Show involving Sheep by the Sheep & Goat Health Scheme, Milton Keynes. The responsibility for the accuracy of the description or pedigree and for the eligibility to compete of the animals entered in the following classes rests solely with the exhibitor.
